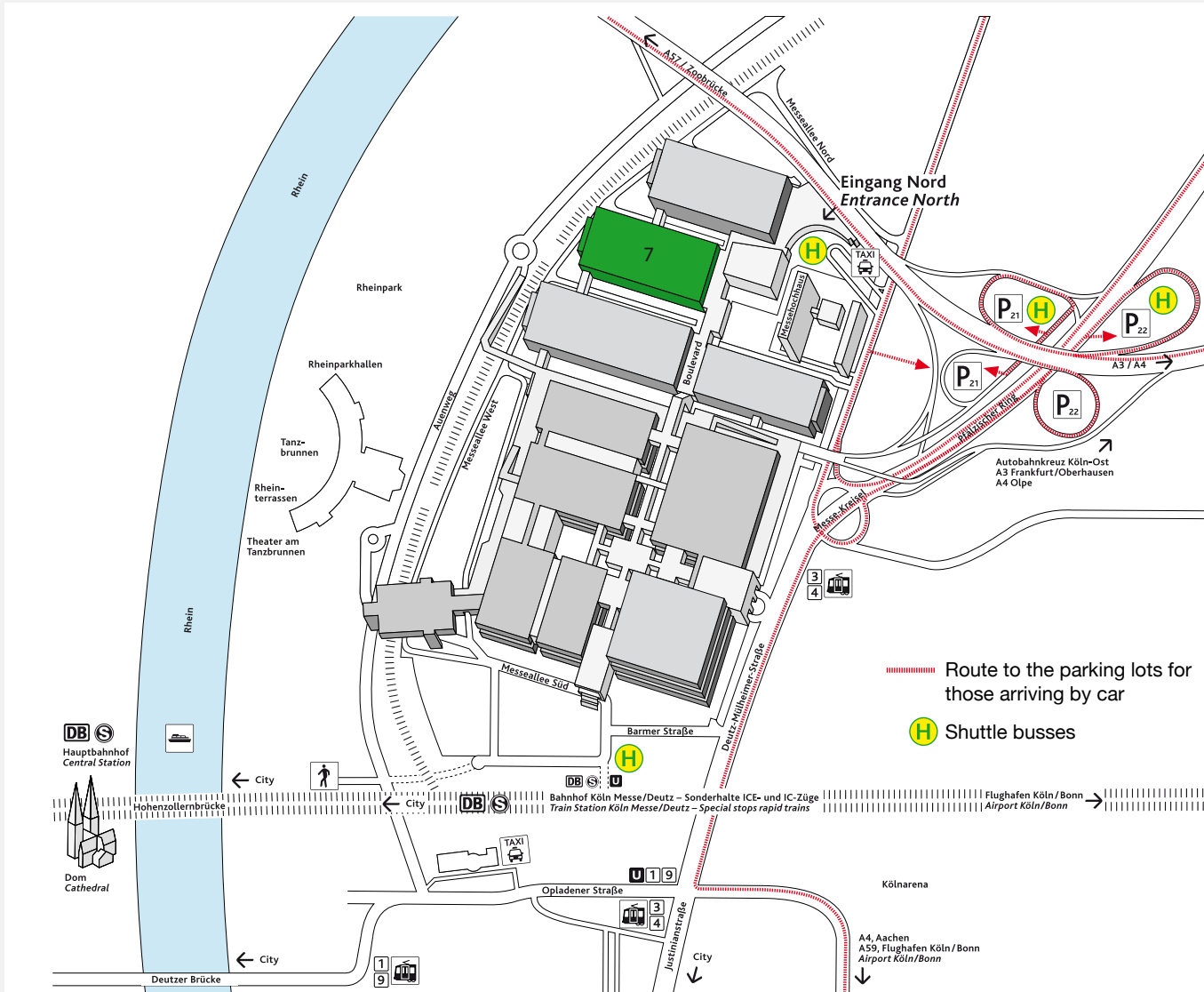


Routes to the Annual Stockholders' Meeting of Bayer AG

at the Cologne-Deutz Exhibition Center (North Entrance) in Cologne on April 25, 2008

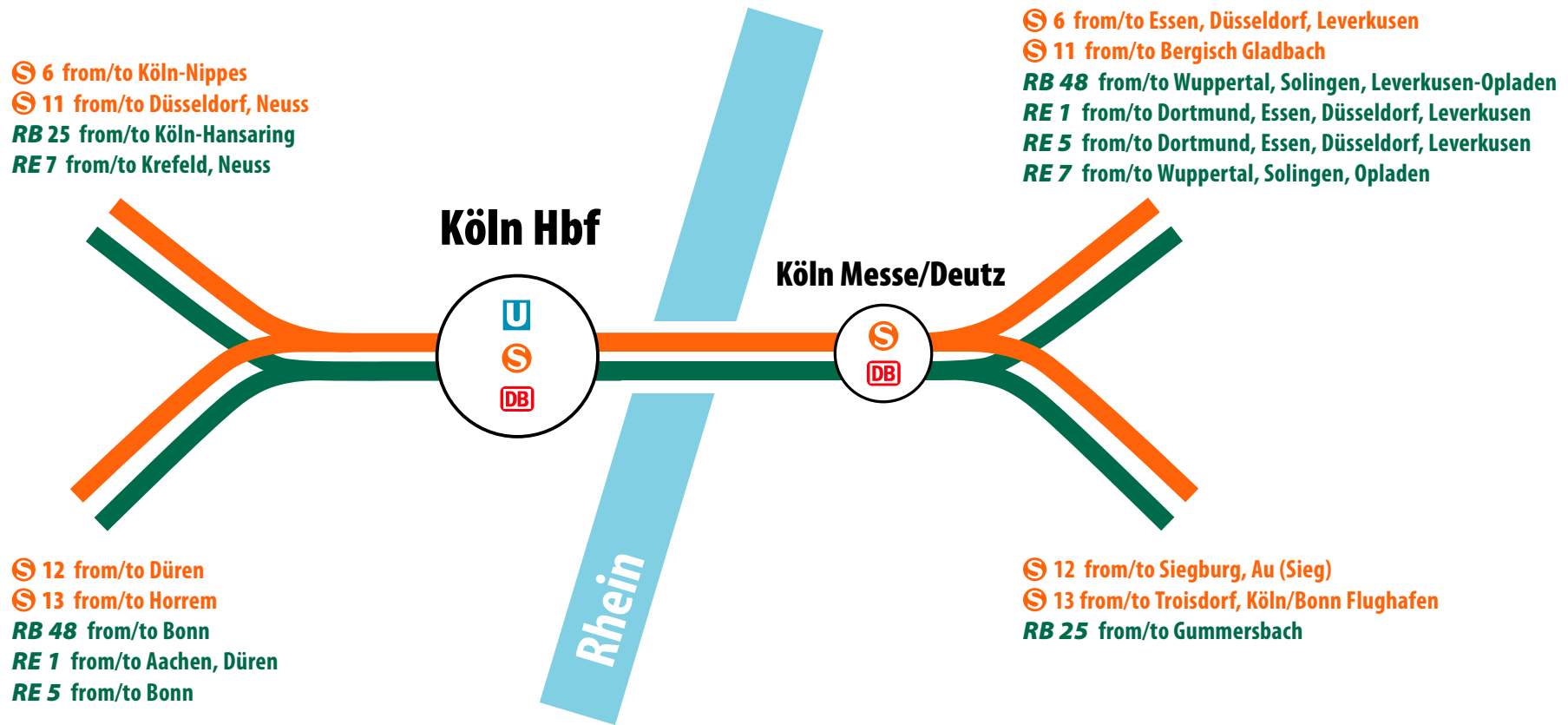


ROUTES

Routes to the Exhibition Center and to the parking lots are signposted with “Messe” (Fair) and “Hauptversammlung (HV) der Bayer AG” (Annual Stockholders' Meeting of Bayer AG). A free shuttle bus service will be provided from the Bahnhof Köln Messe/Deutz (Cologne Exhibition Center/Deutz train station) (exit Barmer Platz) and from the parking lots P 21 and 22 to the North Entrance.

Based on the experience of previous years, the volume of traffic is particularly high just before the start of the Annual Stockholders' Meeting. We therefore recommend that you use public transport. In order to avoid long queues at the security checks, we would also advise you to get there early (doors open at 8:00 a.m.).

If you travel in your own car, please note that the exhibition center is situated in the Cologne City Low Emission Zone. For more information, go to: www.stadt-koeln.de/en/lowemissionzone/index.html



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The DB train station serving the Exhibition Center is the Cologne Exhibition Center/Deutz Station. Free shuttle busses will take you from there (exit Barmer Platz) to the North Entrance.

From Cologne Central Station (platform 10) you can take the suburban trains S 6, S 11, S 12 and S 13 or the regional train RB 25 to the Cologne Exhibition Center/Deutz Station (one stop). The same trains return to the Central Station from the Cologne Exhibition Center/Deutz Station, leaving from platform 10. Trains leave in both directions about every five to ten minutes.

If you are traveling from/to Essen, Düsseldorf and Leverkusen, you can take either the S 6, which leaves every 20 minutes to/from the Cologne Trade Fair/Deutz Station, or the regional express RE 1 or RE 5. The regional express trains RE 7 and RB 48 travel to/from Wuppertal, Solingen and Leverkusen-Opladen. Please see the schedule above for other possible train connections.
